Participants will propose architecture and planning urban interventions onto the iconic Vltava riverbank, one of the richest historic architectural environments in Central Europe. Through analysis of context, students will propose an appropriate contemporary intervention(s) responding to scale, massing, materials and the cultural context of Prague. The workshop will be led by respected architects, planners and historians and participants will also study other iconic urban, architectural and historic sites in Prague.

WORKSHOP OBJECTIVES:

- to encourage critical analysis of traditional European urbanism and architecture
- to work in a multi-disciplinary context to encourage a holistic approach to urbanism
- to provide "real world" solutions, with an eye to the long-term planning goals for the city
