INVITATION

The city of Rabat is preparing to host the second World Summit of local and regional leaders and the 4th Congress of our World Organization, from 1st to 4th October 2013. This event coincides with the one hundredth anniversary of the municipal movement across the world and we wish to make it a moment of sharing and assembly between Africa and the rest of the world.

Due to the high tension of the current context, marked by the economic crisis and the reduced resources at our disposal, we are pushed to imagine new ways of development for our territories with increased solidarity and sustainability.
