The I International Congress on Sustainable Collective Housing occurred at Escuela Técnica Superior de Arquitectura de Barcelona (ETSAB-UPC), between February 25 and 27, 2014 in the context of the 10th edition of the course "Master Laboratorio de la Vivienda Sostenible del Siglo XXI (MLVSSXXI)" directed by Josep Maria Montaner and Zaida Muxí Martínez.

From this first congress, it was proposed to organize an event, every two years. This initiative aims to provide students, professionals and academics dedicated to topics related to architecture and urbanism, a space of reflection, on an international basis, about collective housing and its relationship to contemporary and historical cities.

The IV International Congress on Sustainable Collective Housing will be held from April 20th to 22st, 2020, in Alghero (Sardinia), in collaboration with the Department of Architecture, Design and Urban Planning (DADU), University of Sassari.

As in previous editions, this IV Congress will also feature complementary activities. The Workshop Habitar el Presente will be held from April 15th-18th and on 20th April 2020. On April 17th and 18th, there will be tours of Sardinia (routes through the region), providing the experience to get in touch with the urban form of the city and the residential buildings. In addition, there will also be a poster exhibition of papers related to collective housing.

Proposed papers to the IV International Congress on Sustainable Collective Housing are organized according to five themes:

#### 1. HISTORICAL REVIEWS

History and theory of collective housing  
Analysis of historical and contemporary collective housing projects  
Analysis of the transformations of domestic spaces

#### 2. HOUSING THAT MAKES CITY

Housing policies and urban regeneration processes, social innovation  
Regeneration scales: neighborhood, buildings and housing  
Self-organization and right to housing  
Housing integration processes: policies and projects  
The spaces under the house: inhabiting the public space

#### 3. SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC ISSUES

Other models of access, possession and use: cooperative forms, collaboration, housing sharing  
Variables of the housing emergency: "new" inhabitants, depopulation, tourism, immigrants, refugees  
Housing, cycle and lifestyles  
Urban income and other financial models of housing production

Management of affordable contemporary collective housing  
Housing policies and programs (social housing, sustainable living)  
Right to housing and the city  
Participation of the inhabitants in the management  
The quality of living

Innovation from the typological unit  
Diversity of housing programs according to the typologies  
Typological requalification
